RECORD OF DISCIPLINARY ACTION

In 2009, Jeffrey Connors provided a response to the British Columbia College of Social Workers that he knew was not forthright, honest, and candid, regarding a complaint about possible boundary violations in a personal relationship,

As a result, the registration of Jeffrey Connors was suspended for three (3) months by the British Columbia College of Social Workers effective April 1, 2010. During the term of the suspension, Mr. Connors is prohibited from representing himself as a social worker. In addition, Mr. Connors is required to undergo counseling regarding professional regulation and ethics.
